The Committee spoke by invitation to health classes at Riverfront High School (Looking Glass) on January 10th and 12th. We spoke to a health class at Crow High School on January 13th. At these events, three different young AA volunteers told their stories, one for the first time. We also spoke by invitation at Emergence Addiction and Behavioral Therapies on January 17th.

As of last month, CPC-PI had openings for these positions: A co-chair, a high school coordinator and a U of O representative. Since then, a volunteer has offered to help with high school presentations, and a committee member has offered to stand as co-chair.
